

Pubs and Restaurants

We have put together a list of some pubs and restaurants all within about ½ hours drive (maybe a bit more in high season) which we have been to or which have been recommended by other guests. There are of course many more particularly in Padstow, Fowey or Lostwithiel. The number of restaurants in Cornwall seem to increase daily so please also read the Cornwall Restaurant Guide.

The Crown Inn, Lanlivery

This is our local! A 12th Century longhouse – this very friendly pub has open fires and slate floors. There is a non-smoking restaurant specialising in fish and meat dishes – with a section devoted to Cornish Fare. There is a family room and lovely garden which is safely enclosed for children.

Trewithen Restaurant, Lostwithiel

A much cheaper way to sample Rick Stein's cooking. We love it here for supper – good atmosphere and great food. No bookings taken at lunchtime.

Rick Stein's Fish and Chip Shop

Delicious fish and chips – we recommend taking the ferry over from Rock (just wait on the beach). There can be quite a queue if you want to sit and eat but it generally moves fast – we usually take friends staying – a walk on the beach, ferry ride followed by food and a nice glass of wine or a beer!

Number 6 Padstow –New!
